Coming from the west (from Alaska) on the Alaska Highway, turn right at the intersection with lights at the corner of Hamilton Blvd. and Alaska Highway.

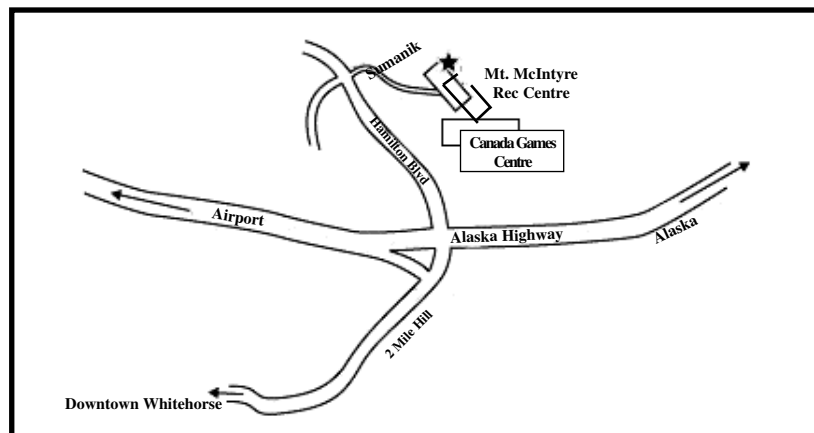
Coming from the east (from the Airport) turn left at the intersection with lights at the corner of Hamilton Blvd. and Alaska Highway.

CAMPING

Testing

Open to Purebred dogs and Mixed Breeds.

Limited Entry: This test is limited to 10 dogs on June 19, 2008, 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm. on show site. Entries must be received by 6:15 pm. on June 19th.

Fees: \$25.00 per dog per entry. Fee includes a CGN crest upon successful completion of the testing.

Test Requirements: Information contained in the booklet is also available on the CKC website: www.ckc.ca.

Required Materials: The handler is required to bring:

- Proof of Vaccination Certificate (Rabies)
- Dog License (if required by local dog control by-laws)
- A leash not less than .75 meters (2') nor longer than 2 metres (6') in length
- An acceptable collar; includes a well fitting slip, buckle or martingale collar, made of fabric, leather or chain. All other types of collars are unacceptable.
- A grooming tool, either a brush or comb or both
- Plastic bags for picking up after your dog.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The building will accept dogs and equipment Thursday, June 14 after 1:00 pm. **Absolutely no admittance prior to 1:00 pm., no exceptions.**
2. Venue opens at 6 am Friday, Saturday & Sunday and closes at 10 pm, Thursday, Friday & Saturday. Exhibitors must vacate the building one hour after Best in Show on Sunday.
3. Showers will be available while the building is open. Exhibitors should be aware that facility management personnel may collect a nominal fee.
4. Loading/unloading area, 15 minutes maximum.
5. All exercise pens must have plastic sheeting underneath.
If space is limited, exercise pens will have to be taken down during show hours.
6. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, **we will be unable to accept entries after the limit of 175 dogs per Show is reached.**
7. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the Entry Form are shown thereon. **Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fees.**
8. Telephone or telegraph entries will not be accepted.
9. The Show & Trial Secretary reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to the CKC Dog Show Rules.
10. A judging schedule will be distributed as soon as possible after entries close.
11. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
12. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and accident, or misfortune, to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
13. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
14. All dogs must be exercised in the areas provided for that purpose. It is the responsibility of the handler/owner to clean up after their dogs. Failure to observe this requirement may result in an immediate expulsion from the Show precincts.
15. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the Show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
16. To avoid noise and confusion there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loudspeaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breed conflicts.
17. All money at the Show will be accepted at **PAR VALUE.**
18. Please note that no babysitting/day care services are available at the show Site.

NOTICE TO OBEDIENCE EXHIBITORS

Obedience Trials are limited to 7 hours of judging on a first come, first accepted basis, Every dog entered in an approved obedience trial must be one of the following: registered with the CKC; have an Event Registration or Performance Event number; eligible for registration with the CKC; or, have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number if designated as a Miscellaneous Class breed. (Sec. 6.1.1)

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

ALL DOGS ENTERED IN A NON-REGULAR CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ON THE SAME DAY

BRACE CLASS: Is open to any two dogs of any breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs, nor that they be of the same breed, except when entered in a breed specialty obedience trial. The Brace Class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class. The 2 dogs shall be hitched together with a brace chain or coupling and are judged on the performance of the 2 dogs as though they were one. Exhibitors may enter more than one brace in this class, but must have a separate handler for each brace in the Long Sit and Long Down Exercises when judged in the same group.

TRANSITION OBEDIENCE CLASSES

PRE-NOVICE - This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together in the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

NON-REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

Note: Any dog entered in a Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition only on the same day; dogs being entered in a parade may be spayed, neutered or in an unorthodox trim PROVIDED they are entered in Exhibition Only. Entrants are requested to provide a SHORT bio on the dog, PRINTED or TYPED and presented to the Show Secretary at least one hour prior to the event.

BRACE CLASS

"This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). The class shall be judged after Best of Breed - after judging of the group and before Best in Show. A Brace should be judged as an identical pair - same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled 1 person on 1 lead." S.12.6.1(a).

PARADE OF CHAMPIONS

Friday, June 20th, at Noon - This class shall be for all dogs that have met all requirements of CKC Championship status. Entrants are requested to provide a SHORT bio on the dog, PRINTED or TYPED and presented to the Show Secretary at least one hour prior to the event.

CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES

Chapter 13, Section 5, Sub Section 2 of the Dog Show Rules states:

When the premium list indicates that entries will be limited, cancellation of entries will not be permitted.

NEW CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB RULES EFFECTIVE JAN. 1st, 2006

Section 8.2.5: An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour prior to the start of the show;

Section 8.5.8: In the case of a judge change (substitute or overload), an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes within the show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition (Armband) number. A new entry, along with accompanying fees, will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to one hour prior to the opening of the show (see **Section 3.32, 3.51 and 8.54**).

Section 12.2.1: 12 - 18 month class has been added.

Section 12.3.1: A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Group is not required to stay for Best Puppy in Show.

JUNIOR HANDLING

Intermediate Novice Class: from 11-14 years who have NOT won six firsts in the same class with competition.

Intermediate Open Class: From 11- 14 years who have won six firsts in the same class with competition.

*(Please note that 12-18 month dogs/bitches will compete as adults and are not eligible for puppy awards)

MOVING A DOG TO SPECIALS

Chapter 13, Section 13: A dog which '**individually registered at time of closing**' in the records of The Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of a Championship, after the closing date for entries for a Show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in **writing** at least **one hour prior to the opening of the show**, by the owner or handler.

Junior Handling is open to all persons from 4 years up to but not including 18 years of age. All dogs must be entered in a Regular Class at the All Breed Show (on the same day this event is being held), but need not be owned by the junior. Trophies and rosettes will be awarded for the First in each class (except Peewee class, who receive a Participant flat ribbon) and for Best Overall Handler. Entries will be accepted at the Show & Trial Secretary's desk on the morning of Saturday, June 21, for the event to be held at noon that day. Entries will close one hour before the competition and fees are \$5.00 per entry.

CHAMPIONSHIPS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated dog-awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & More
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5
*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS						

To determine the number of Championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

Further Section 15.1.12 (c) has been added and states the dog must: have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

The system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another dog, either at the breed level or at the group level) if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group, as listed thereunder:

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than 5 points at any single Show.

TO OBTAIN AN "EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER" OR A "PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER"

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN or PEN number. Include payment in full - \$55.00 Canadian for an ERN and \$50.00 Canadian for a PEN. Accounts may be paid with a personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to unstable currency rates. Provide a full return address. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure that your Visa or MasterCard number is legible and you have included your expiry date and signature. An ERN number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If a factor beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem send a written request for a 30-day extension. CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex:

Junior Puppy	A dog between 6 months & 9 months on the day of the Show
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months & 12 months on the day of the Show
12-18 Month	A dog between 12 months & 18 months on the day of the Show
Canadian Bred	A dog, which is born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor	The handler of the dog is also the Owner/Breeder
Open Class	All dogs
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions
Brace	Two dogs of the same breed, not necessarily same sex or identical ownership. Effective Jan.1.06

OBEDIENCE TRIALS

Only one dog may be entered in Novice A and Open A per registered owner.

NOVICE "A": No licensed handler, trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.

NOVICE "B": Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person and shall be for purebred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada.

OPEN "A": No licensed handler, no trainer nor any person, who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or Elsewhere, shall be allowed to compete as an exhibitor or any score awarded will be canceled.

OPEN "B": Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person and shall be for purebred dogs of any breed which have won the title of C.D. in Canada.

UTILITY: This class shall be for purebred dogs of any breed, which shall have won the title of C.D.X. in Canada. Handlers, trainers and kennel employees may compete in this class.

A dog which has earned a C.D. degree in the USA is not eligible for entry in the Novice "A" Class and a dog which has earned it's C.D.X. in the USA is not eligible for entry in the Open "A" Class. Such dogs must be entered in the "B" Classes respectively.

NOTE: The word trainer means any person who conducts a dog obedience training class or who regularly assists with the training of dogs in said class, or who regularly trains dogs belonging to persons outside his or her immediate family.

CHAPTER 6, SECTION 6.7.1: Where any of the Obedience Trial regulations require that a dog shall have won a particular obedience title before being entered in a particular obedience class or test, eligibility to enter that class shall be determined as follows: A dog may be entered in any such class in any obedience trial of which the final closing date occurs after his handler has been notified by the required number of different judges that the dog has won three qualifying scores of the required title, even though the owner has not received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. However the winner shall forfeit any prizes or qualifying scores won in the particular class if the CKC does not subsequently notify the owner officially that the required title has been won, or in the case of miscellaneous breed, the required title has been qualified for. No dog may be entered in Novice & Open Class or both Open Class "A" and Utility Class at the same Obedience Trial.

EXTRACTS FROM CKC DOG SHOW RULES

Chapter 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

Section 3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules as a listed dog, provided:

- a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

A listing fee of \$8.40 must accompany the entry of a listed dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 2.3

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being cancelled and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.2

DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonoured cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16, Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules.
