

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

BORDER CROSSING

Government regulations require that to be brought into Canada, a dog MUST have a current Rabies Certificate dated at least 30 days prior to entry.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

(Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog)

For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain Championship status, and Obedience Titles and Degrees, individual registration is no longer required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of obtaining points, scores or awards to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of the dog's foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (\$57.75 Canadian Funds) along with a letter of request to the CKC. This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering CKC events ONLY.

RV PARKING

Exhibitors camp at their own risk.

No parking will be allowed in the loading area at the back of the building. Off loading and loading will be allowed for 15 minutes. Please respect this area.

RALLY OBEDIENCE TROPHY LIST

Exhibitors eligible for trophies must notify the Trials chair prior to showing.

All prizes will be awarded for qualifying scores only. The exhibitor or a representative must be present when prizes are awarded.

HIGHEST QUALIFYING DOG in RALLY NOVICE A, RALLY NOVICE B, RALLY ADVANCED A, AND RALLY ADVANCED B will receive \$15 and a Rosette. Rosettes will be offered to 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place qualifiers in each class.

Both trials - The Yukon Kennel Club offers a prize for the Highest Qualifying Score earned by a Yukon Kennel Club member in each trial.

LISTING FEES:

The Club must reject an incomplete entry form and promptly return it to whoever submitted it, be it the owner, lessee or authorized agent. (Sec.6.2.2)

The entry of a dog at a trial must be accompanied by the entry fees. (Sec. 6.3.2)

Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. (Sec.6.3.3)

Conditional entries or entries accompanied by post-dated cheques will not be accepted.

FEMALES IN SEASON

When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. The entry fee, service charge and listing fee will be refunded. (Sec. 6.5.2).

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CLASSES will be offered in both trials: RALLY NOVICE A & B, and RALLY ADVANCED A & B and EXHIBITION. Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries.

DISCIPLINE

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving Club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a trial held under the CKC Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Sec. 17.7)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

It is the responsibility of each competitor to be familiar with and abide by the Canadian Kennel Club Rally obedience Trial Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2007.

INDOOR CRATING

There will be limited room for crates and exercise pens in the building.

RULES GOVERNING ALL RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIALS

1. Dogs must be kept under control at all times and on leash at all times within the building with the exception of the rally obedience ring. No dogs will be allowed within the trial precincts during the trials unless officially entered with the exception of Certified Assistance Dogs.
2. Collars other than those specified in these rules are not allowed within the ring. Collars used in rally must be the same as those accepted for use in obedience trials (Sec. 8.16.1)
3. The Yukon Kennel Club will use all reasonable care to ensure the safety of the dogs exhibited but will not be responsible for or assume any liability for loss or injury to any dog or exhibitor. If for any reason beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or complete the trials no refund of entry fees will be made.
4. Dogs must be judged in catalogue order to the extent that it is practical to do so. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. (Sec. 8.6)
5. Any dog entered and received at a rally obedience trial must compete in all exercises of all classes in which it is entered, unless excused by the judge, official veterinarian, superintendent, or the trial chair. (Sec. 6.4.1)
6. To be eligible to enter in the Rally Novice A or Rally Advanced A class a dog must not have previously earned a CKC Novice obedience title. The handler of any dog in these classes must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families (Sec. 9.1.1 and 9.2.1)
7. A dog which has earned a comparable CKC rally obedience title is not eligible for entry in the respective Rally Novice A or Rally Advanced A classes. Such dogs must be entered in the 'B' classes if eligible. (Sec. 9.2.1 & 10.2.1)
8. Every dog entered in an approved obedience trial must be one of the following: registered with the CKC; have an Event Registration or Performance Event number; eligible for registration with the CKC; or, have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number if designated as a miscellaneous class breed. (Sec. 6.1.1)
9. Please keep the building and grounds clean. Please pick up after your dog.

The PRECINCTS of these trials will be within a 30 foot perimeter of all rings and other areas reserved for the Club.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Rally Novice A

Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Novice obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

Rally Novice B

Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Advanced A

This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title or any CKC Novice obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial

Rally Advanced B

This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog competing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

**The dogs jump height shall be given on the entry form.

EXTRACTS FROM CKC DOG SHOW RULES

Chapter 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

Section 3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules as a listed dog, provided:

- a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

A listing fee of \$8.40 must accompany the entry of a listed dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 2.3

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being cancelled and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.2

DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonoured cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16, Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules.

CHAPTER 9 - EXHIBITORS and THEIR DOGS

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

FOREIGN BORN MINIATURE DACHSHUNDS

FOREIGN-BORN Miniature Dachshunds if eligible for registration in the CKC, may be shown as a listed dog up to the age of one (1) year. The owner(s) must then submit an application for registration to the CKC within thirty (30) days. The listing fee for a Miniature Dachshund will be \$2.00 per show. Failure to comply with these rulings will automatically cancel any previous wins and awards. Foreign registration number must be shown.
